



Bulldog Crimson/Gold Camp 2020-2021 FAQ

Does my kid have to wear a mask?

Yes. All participants and staff are required to wear a mask indoors and outdoors when social distance cannot be followed.

How is drop off going to work?

We will be following the guidelines the CDC, IDPH, and KCHP have instructed us to follow. It is per their recommendation that the following will be enforced:

- Do not park, but pull up to the gym doors (next to the picnic tables) just past the main entrance.
- Stay in your car along with your child. Please call 630-768-3720 and staff will come out and ask a set of health questions needing your signature.
- Once the questionnaire has been filled out, staff will open the door for your child and take them inside.
- No guardians are allowed inside or allowed to come to the door. All parents will be instructed to return to their vehicle.

How is pick up going to work?

This will be a similar policy to pick up.

- Once you arrive, please call 630-768-3720, let them know your arrival and for who.
- A staff member will bring out your child, open the car door and make sure they are inside.
- Staff will not be able to help with seatbelts or boosters.
- There will be no signing out process.

Will my child need to bring any supplies?

- If your child is issued a chromebook from school they will need to bring it and the charger to do their eLearning, and headphones. Please make sure that your child knows their login information.
- Each student should bring their own refillable water bottle.
- We ask that you send your child with snacks for your children as we will have a designated snack time in both the AM and PM section. If your child is registered for Lunch Bunch they will need to bring their own lunch. We are not able to provide any food.
- Any other supplies they may need to do their eLearning such as notebook, pencils, pens, calculator, etc.
- We recommend they bring a book bag to keep their chromebooks and personal supplies in while they are doing other activities.

Will you provide snacks?

No. Food will not be served in our programming. We ask that you send your child with two snacks as we will have a designated snack time in both the AM and PM section. If your child is registered for Lunch Bunch they will need to bring their own lunch.

How will staff keep my child safe?

- Staff have to daily self-certify their own health before coming into work.
- Staff will be instructed on all COVID-19 guidelines given to us by the CDC, IDPH and KCHP.
- Staff have the same mask policy as the children.
- Staff will be cleaning common areas regularly and each after activity.
- Leaving and entering the room will require a use of hand sanitizer for all.
- Staff will be in charge of disinfection each participant's individual supplies each night.

What happens if my children get exposed to COVID?

At this time, someone is considered exposed or a close contact if they are closer than 6 ft for over 15 minutes. If a participant or staff was exposed they will be asked to self-quarantine for 14 days following the date of exposure. A contact of a contact (someone the participant or staff lives with came in close contact with someone with COVID-19) will not self-quarantine. All these guidelines are subject to change by the IDPH, KCHD and CDC.

What happens if my children get diagnosed with COVID?

If a participant or staff tests positive for COVID-19 please notify Brittany Meyer, 630-768-3715, our staff will work in conjunction with the Health Department to notify close contacts, (close contacts are outlined above). Close contacts will be asked to voluntarily quarantine at home for 14 days following the date of exposure.

Will I get reimbursed if my kids get diagnosed, or have to self quarantine?

Depending on the situation, we will work with the family on refunds. This will be a case by case basis. We will do our best to be flexible in this difficult time.

Is there something for the days off from school?

Yes! We provide a day camp program on days off from school that the Park District is open. These are a separate registration called Klub Fun. We will be on-site or walking to local parks. We will not be taking field trips for the first half of the school year.
